## Borrowing books

You can borrow several books at the same time. Borrowing is free. You need a library card to borrow books. You can get it from the library's customer service. Children can get their own library card if needed. Parents are always responsible for the loans of children under 15 years old.

The due date for returns is on the loan receipt.

Take care of the loaned books and return them to the library on time!
