- Prepared for all children in early childhood education .
- Created together with the staff and the parents.
- The child's wishes and individual needs are taken into account.



VASU DISCUSSION:

- A meeting between the early childhood education teacher and the parents to prepare the vasu plan.
- Held at the daycare centre.
- The use of an interpreter is possible.
- Lasts about one hour.

VASU INCLUDES:

- The child's strengths and interests.
- The parents' views and wishes concerning their child's upbringing.
- Goals for the staff that support the child's wellbeing and learning.
- Possible support needs.
- Other matters agreed between the parents and the daycare staff.

- Can be on paper or digital.
- Is confidential.
- Implementation is monitored regularly.
- Updated at least once a year.



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HOW TO PREPARE FOR THE VASU DISCUSSION?

- Think in advance about what you want to discuss.
- What does your child like doing at home?
- What makes your child happy?
- Is there something that makes them sad or afraid?
- What wishes do you have for the daycare regarding your child?
